A New State of Affairs - Canvas Draft State

Canvas has recently released the highly anticipated Draft State feature that allows for content in Assignments, Quizzes, Modules, Pages, and Discussions to be in an unpublished (draft) state even if the course is published. Draft content will be invisible to students and excluded from grade calculations, giving faculty an opportunity to further develop assignments or activities before releasing them in the course. In this hands-on session we will explore how to successfully manage this new state of affairs in Canvas.
